**GENERATION TARIFF EFFECTIVE FROM 1<sup>st</sup> APRIL, 2017**

In exercise of powers conferred under Section 64(4) and other relevant provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003, the Odisha Electricity Regulatory Commission (OERC) has passed an order on dt.23.03.2017 in Case No.62 of 2016 with regard to determination of Aggregate Revenue Requirement and Generation Tariff for Odisha Power Generation Corporation Ltd.(OPGC) for FY 2017-18 effective from 01.04.2017.

The OPGC hereby notify the following Schedule of Generation Tariff for sale of power to GRIDCO Ltd. by OPGC with effect from 01.04.2017 which shall remain in force until further order of the Commission.

## **Odisha Power Generation Corporation Ltd.**

Odisha Power Generation Corporation (OPGC) Ltd. was filed its tariff application before OERC for determination of Generation Tariff of its 2x210 MW Ib Thermal Power Station for the year 2017-18 after withdrawal of Special Leave Petition (Civil) Nos.6812-13 of 2005 from the Hon'ble Supreme Court. This application has been registered as Case No.62 of 2016. In its consultative process, the Commission conducted a public hearing and heard the Applicant, Objectors, Consumer Counsel and the Representative of the Dept. of Energy, Government of Odisha at length. OERC has carefully examined and analysed the tariff proposal of OPGC, the written and oral submissions of the objectors have been taken into consideration while deciding the generation tariff of OPGC for FY 2017-18. The Commission in its order passed in Case No.62 of 2016 has determined the annual capacity charge of Rs.207.52 crore @ 72.52 p/u and energy charge of Rs.354.08 crore @ 123.745 p/u for the said power station of OPGC. Hence the cost of power purchase for procurement of 2861.50 MU from OPGC comes to Rs.561.60 crore (Rs.207.52 crore+Rs.354.08 crore) @ 196.26 p/u. Further, in the said tariff order of OPGC, the Commission has provisionally approved an amount of Rs.52.31 crore to be reimbursed by OPGC from GRIDCO towards year end charges for the FY 2017-18. Previous year 2016-17, while passed the tariff order of OPGC, the Commission had approved Rs. 544.44 crore @ 190.26 p/u for procurement of 2861.50 MU from the same station of OPGC.
