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**THE ADDITIONAL INFORMATION PROVIDED TO BE CONSIDERED IN
THE HEARING**

Case No- 51/2025

**(Before the ODISHA Electricity Regulatory Commission,
Bhubaneswar)**

1. That at the outset the monopoly of above said distribution licensees-TPNODL indifferent matters are found due to the only reason that Tata Power have been awarded licensees' of distribution & supply of Electricity in four Distribution Zones in single tender though it was beyond the provisions of Orissa Electricity Reforms policies.
2. That Company is spending expenditure under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activities which is to be met out of Profit whereas they are including such expenses under Administrative and General Expenditures (A&G Expenses) which is not scrupulously verified while determining Tariff in the ARR application resulting the poor consumers are contributing through tariff, which is not legally justified.
3. That petty materials and activities viz. interposing pole, AB switch, HG Fuse, short span cable and wire changes etc. are booked under CAPEX instead of O&M Expenses thus canvassing the CAPEX which ultimately the DISCOM is rewarded with Interest, Depreciation and ROE.
4. That TPNODL is spending the Employee expenses on the personnel transferred from other TATA POWER companies except to the personnel assigned in the Vesting Order coughing out higher salary including Incentives which is borne by the Consumer alternatively through Tariff Setting.

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5. That the company is not making prudent practice of financial concurrence while rewarding Purchase Order and Work Orders and so also the concurrent audit while scrutinizing the invoices thus leakages in the expenses are not arrested.

6. That the audit procedure is doubtful since the counterpart auditor of State's Share is not protecting the interest of the State and consumer. They are in collusion with the TP's appointed auditor i.e. E&Y. The counterpart auditors are rewarded with various consultancy assignment in Pseudo Names. Thus the commission should scrutinize all the consultancy expenses as booked in their accounts.

7. That the company is not maintaining prudence in the expenditure of A&G and O&M expenses which is should be in align with the Regulatory Business thus creating unnecessary burden to the consumers.

8. That TPNODL is being granted with the license for 25 years whereas they are recruiting the employees in the structure where they can be transferred to any other states thus impacts the interest of the company. Instead they should recruit under State Cadre to maintain the continuity of the business if the license to Tata Power ceases. Since the state cadre recruitment is stopped time will arise the commission shall not be able to revoke the license since Tata Power shall withdraw or transfer all the personnel to other DISCOMS thus situation will warrant the commission cannot handover the business to any other bidder.

9. That the quality and standard are not properly maintained in Capex where the cost of the assets are overstated. The Commission should scrutinize the activities of costing of each component of CAPEX to be scrutinized.

10. That TPNODL has incurred sizeable amount in GIS implementation. The present status and benefits of the GIS Implementation to be verified.

11. That the commission should scrutinise each line item of expenses under CAPEX, A&G, Employee Cost - CTC, and O&M Expenses.

12. That when the employees are recruited why for the each activities the third party consultants, agencies are engaged. Even HR activities are hired.

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13. That false Capitalization without JMC
14. That materials stolen or shortages are treated as consumed
15. That payments are released to the contractor whereas the materials consumed are of poor quality.
16. That rampant misuse and corruption in hired vehicles that effecting the general consumers in A&G expenses.
17. That and release of vendors dues through BAcels adopting unfair means discriminating vendors among specific vendors since last four years all though other vendors are unduly harassed months together on the plea of non-compliances with high handedness restricting their genuine claim needs investigation thoroughly.
18. That the expenditure incurred under TPNODL for Civil Works construction, renovation, development of office building, store and corporate office and NESCO Guest House at Balasore amounting Rs.40,73,92,869.47 for various establishments including expenditure surmounting Rs.6.24 crores & Rs.2.95 lakh for rented space respectively for NOCCI and Udyog Bhavan according to information supplied through RTI seems to be excessive beyond approval of BoD and provisions of Vesting order-needs strict proof of justifications. (The RTI Information is enclosed here with under Annexure-1)
19. That TPNODL though supplied the list of vendors to execute different activities including above civil works but denied in reply to RTI replies to provide the bidding documents/tendering documents on the plea that documents are confidential in nature in absence of which the manner and process of competitive bidding are doubtful, must be disclosed during the preceding for the transparency of bidding.
20. That the informations obtained by RTI from TPNODI about Goods Received Note(GRN) in the store qtr. wise for last four years purchase orders amounting Rs.1234,93,75,364.30 (approx 1235 crore) but no details of contractor and utilisation of materials has been disclosed which is not seems to be transparent

business .The GST record of TPNODL should be ensured accordingly. (The information under RTI is enclosed here with under Annexure-2)

21. That the information about Scarp materials sold during last four years amounting Rs.52.31 crores but not disclosed the list of vendors and manner of sale about tender or bidding process with utilization of the fund out of the sale.

22. That vendors/ B.A agencies are engaging technical employees having not requisite qualifications as per the ELBO guideline to execute job like AMC works, 33/11kv line & PSS derogating the express conditions of regulations prescribed under Electrical Licensing Board Regulations Odisha, 2014.

23. That the BA agencies are entrusting unauthorized persons those are not qualify to work & handle high voltage lines and equipment such as supervisors, safety officers ,lineman as per terms of tender overlooked by TPNODL intentionally deviating the prescribed norms under Vesting Order.

24. That the permit to work as per Bureau of Indian Standard though prescribed earlier during Gridco period yet TPNODL has introduced an new guideline without due approval of BoD as well as OERC which is against the provisions of Vesting Order obtaining due approval from OERC.

25. That the provision of Group Health Insurance was earlier introduced for all employees under state public sector undertakings of Odisha state in the manner prescribed without any provisions of copay & capping systems but TPNODL has discriminately introduced such provision with higher premium annually for Five lakh floating coverage but in case of CTC employees annual package of twenty five lakh with premium of small amount. The authenticity of such actions with different provisions for employees of one & same organization by TPNODL is illegal.

26. That it is fact that provisional assessments are claimed after inspecting the premises of consumers under section-126 of Electricity Act'03 not by designated and prescribed authorities and assessing penalty although assessing officer not a member of the team detecting the un-authorized use of electricity and claiming provisional assessment but without serving the same as per statutory provisions Codified for section 126 of the Act'03 rather TPNODL messaging on Whatsapp to

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settle the issue with allowing rebate of 40% less without following the manner of proceeding under sec-126 which is doubtful and not transparent.

27. That the additional further information may also be added at the time of hearing if required.

28. That the facts stated above are true to best of the knowledge and belief.
